February 20, 1925 - May 14, 2025

On Wednesday, May 14, 2025 HENRY MARTIN PRICE transitioned from life to everlasting life. Henry was born on February 20, 1925. He was the son of the Late Charlie Price and Lucy Wentworth.

He was educated in the Baltimore City Public Schools. Henry spent 3 years in the United States Marines with the first black Marines out of Montford Point.

He married the love of his life, the Late Nellie D. Price and was married sixty-six years.

He spent his working career, thirty-three years at the Department of Army where he received \$60,000 in awards for inventions and numerous certificates of Merit for Safety and Superior Performance. He later worked at Hochschild Kohn & Co. and retired after 28 years and 10 years at K-Mart. He loved his son, grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Henry was preceded in death by his wife, Nellie and parents, Charles and Lucy Price.
