Henry Lee Taylor, 74, was born September 8, 1943 to the late Henry James and Emma Lee Taylor in Fort Devens, Massachusetts. He was called home to God's pearly gates on September 21, 2017. He is preceded in death by his wife of 42 years, Doris Taylor and his brother, Robert James Taylor.

At an early age he accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior and was united with Little Piney Grove Baptist Church in Virginia Beach, Virginia. He later moved to Richmond and continued his spiritual journey by visiting many churches. Henry received his formal education from James Weldon Johnson High School in Yorktown, Virginia, where he graduated.

On May 5, 1965, Henry enlisted into the United States Army serving his country proudly and was honorably discharged on April 19, 1967. Following his service in the United States Army, he worked as a civilian at the Naval Weapons Station in Yorktown, Virginia. He furthered his career and worked for the United States Postal Service as a Parts and Tools Clerk for 30 years of dedicated service.

him as being upbeat and full of life. We were so fortunate to have had him in our lives and we feel empty without him. In his leisure, he enjoyed fishing, working on cars and gardening in his yard.
