



Herbert Allen "Debo" Dabney III

May 17, 1951 - April 9, 2020

Herbert Allen Dabney, III, 68 of Richmond, Virginia departed this life on Thursday, April 9, 2020, at Vibra Hospital to the pearly gates of heaven to continue his musical concert at the highest level ever. He is preceded in death by his father, Herbert Allen Dabney, Jr.; mother, Claudia M. Ingram and grandmother, Thelma A. Dabney.

Herbert affectionately known as "Debo" is one of the areas most dynamic and animated pianist. While playing the ivory keys for the last 45 years, he has played with a full repertoire from Jazz to Gospel, R&B, Swing, Blues and Children's Classics. He was a unique and rare artist whose personality and performances were so charming that his musical brilliance seemed effortless. His touch and approach to the keyboard was joyfully and spiritually known. He was a master virtuoso of his time and will truly be missed, however not forgotten.

Debo was a native of Manakin, Virginia. He graduated from Maggie Walker High School, Class of 1969, and furthered his education at Norfolk State University with a major in music.

Debo also served as a music coordinator for Trinity Baptist Church in Richmond, Virginia, for 20 years and Sixth Baptist Church for 3 years. A man of spiritual belief, strength and courage that always held his own. His smile

was like a ray of sunshine that would elevate a room into joy. Always sacrificing, optimistic, and truly a class act of musical talent.

Herbert Allen Dabney III is survived by his caring and loving wife of 19 years, Celestine W. Dabney; daughter, Sandra Carey (Lorenzo); sister, Beverly Davis (Tyrone); sister, Pamela Ingram; brother, Frank Ingram; brother André Dabney (Deiree).

Debo's love also spread to his in-laws; starting with a wonderful mother in-law, Teola Culter Washington and father in-law, Joseph Sr. (deceased). Other in-laws: Joseph Jr. (deceased); Lawrence Washington; Deacon Otelia Thomas (Deacon Thermond); Helen W. Jefferson (Purcell Sr. - deceased); Deacon Louis Washington (Rev. Lucy Washington); James Otis Washington (Kim), as well as a host of other relatives and extended church family.

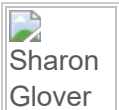

The world knew him as Debo because of his musical accomplishments and talents (heck I recall visiting at his house back in the day and he was playing a trumpet), but to me he is still affectionately known as "Opie"- heck I never knew his name was Herbert or that he was the "III". 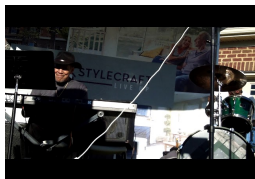
