Herbert Rainey, Jr., born on June 15, 1951, in Richmond, VA, to the late Vivian Deane Rainey and Herbert Rainey, Sr., peacefully transitioned from this life, leaving behind a legacy of love, faith, and service. A proud graduate of Virginia Randolph High School, Class of 1969, Herbert Jr. was the first in his family to earn a college degree, graduating with a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Virginia Commonwealth University in 1975. His pursuit of knowledge and growth was a hallmark of his character, evident in both his personal and professional life.

Later in life, Herbert Jr. found a spiritual home with the Israelite Nation Worldwide Ministry, where his faith in God became an unshakable foundation. If you asked him about his beliefs, he would tell you with the conviction and grace that defined his spirit.

Herbert Jr. dedicated over 30 years to the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice, where he served as a tireless advocate for youth. His commitment to the well-being of young people was not just his job—it was his calling, and he carried out this mission with passion and integrity.

In his leisure, Herbert Jr. was an adventurer of the mind and body. At 19, he discovered a passion for martial arts and began studying Karate, where he quickly realized his talent for powerful kicks. He also found joy in reading,

writing, traveling, exercising, and spending time with his beloved friends, especially his “OGs” from Central Gardens. He was also known for his vibrant spirit when it came to singing karaoke, where his voice and presence could light up a room.

Herbert Jr. leaves behind cherished memories with his two sisters, Lillie Rainey and Melba Rainey-Sayed, his brother-in-law, Magdy Sayed, two nieces, Kelli Rainey and Manal Sayed, and a vast community of extended family members and friends who will forever hold him close in their hearts.

Herbert Rainey, Jr.’s life was one of kindness and generosity, and his legacy will continue to inspire all who were fortunate enough to know him. He will be deeply missed but never forgotten.
