Hilda Alverta Wright was born the second eldest of four girls on April 6, 1924 to the late William and Lottie Carter in Baltimore, Maryland.

Alverta, as she preferred to be called, attended the Baltimore City Public School System. In 1940, Alverta married William Brown, Sr. (deceased) and in 1959 she married Robert Lee Wright, Sr. (deceased). Alverta held positions with several companies throughout her employment career which included Henryton Sanitation, London Fog Coat Factory, Bernie's Hat Factory, and retired from Howard Johnson's Hotel; at which time, she became a member of the Foster Grandparents' Volunteer Program for the next twenty years. She was a volunteer Judge with the Board of Elections for more than thirty-five years as well.

Alverta loved attending family events or just simply spending time with her family. If it was something going on, she wanted to be there having fun with everyone else. She was a pretty good "duck pin" bowler receiving several first place trophies. Alverta traveled to many places throughout the world. Although Alverta lived a frugal lifestyle, her favorite place to visit was Atlantic City. She enjoyed playing roulette and the nickel slot machines. During her down time, Alverta enjoyed reading, playing handheld slot machines and solving advanced crossword puzzles. Standing at 4 feet, 9 inches with picture perfect posture in high heeled shoes, Alverta was always the tallest person in the

room. She could think quickly on her feet and was the go-to person for solving problems. Like many of us, she made mistakes along the way, but she tried her best to correct them.
