"KOZAR" TYRONE GOODE was born in Towson, Maryland on August 24, 1985 to Paulette and Harry Goode, Sr. Kozar was considered the "miracle baby" of the Greater Baltimore Medical Center of August 1985. Beating all odds, he was born premature weighing only 2 lbs 9 oz. Kozar fought for his life to begin and fought for his life when it suddenly ended. He departed this life tragically, Sunday, September 8, 2003. He was the youngest of three children. Kozar received his education at Parkville High School and was in the process of enrolling into TESST Technology Institute for a continued education and advanced computer programming. Kozar was a brilliant and beautiful young man. Not like the average teen in many ways, Kozar didn't have an enemy in the world or a mean bone in his body. He was loved by all that knew him and adored by those who were blessed enough to have met him. Kozar's wide eyes and pearly white smile would often soften the hardest of hearts. Kozar was well known for his expertise in computer technology and his acquired interest of sci-fi video games and animation. He was a well rounded individual, athletic and very poised for a young man of his age. He loved God first "through all things that strengthens him", computers, sports, cooking, drawing and most of all he loved his family and friends. Kozar would graciously give his last of anything to anyone who wanted it. Children loved to be in Kozar's presence and would talk about him for hours on end after leaving him. Kozar was a beautiful person inside and out; only wonderful words could be used to describe such a magnificent person. He was a proud

member of Covenant of Life Worship Center under the leadership of Pastor Tony Golphin-Hill. Special thanks to the men and women of Sinai Hospital's emergency room in Baltimore, Maryland for assisting in the last fight of Kozar's life. This fight was one of the greatest battles until God called him, telling him "Come home My child," where his soul was set free. Kozar leaves to mourn: parents, Paulette and Harry Sr., one sister, Nonna-Marie Kirby and one brother Harry "Bootsie" Jr.; niece Raven Lynn; nephew Harry III; two adopted sisters, Shana Clay and Patricia Brown; one adopted brother, Brian Clay; one brother-in-law, Ira Kirby; one sister-in-law, Dana Goode and a host of other friends and extended relatives that will cherish his memory forever always.

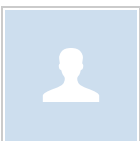
