HOWARD ONEAL, "LT" MYERS, devoted husband of Hortense Myers, departed this life on January 28, 2013 to be with the Lord.

Howard was born on November 22, 1950 in Baltimore, Maryland. He graduated from Fairmount Hill High School. He further pursued his education at Bay College and the University of Baltimore.

He served in the United States Army and Army Reserves for over eighteen years, attaining the rank of sergeant. He served in Vietnam for two years. During Operation Desert Storm he was recalled to active duty and was stationed in Germany where he served another six months.

Howard married Hortense Douglas on September 6, 1975. From this union they were blessed with two sons.

Howard worked for the State of Maryland as a police officer for over thirty-seven years, two years at the University of Baltimore and over thirty-five years at his beloved Morgan State University where he attained the rank of lieutenant and became Operations Chief.

He was a loyal member of the Federal Order of Police, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the National Association of Chiefs of Police. He was an avid

reader, a student of history; he possessed vast knowledge of anything military.
