After being honorably discharged from active duty, Hubert returned home and secured a job with John Vitale & Sons as plumber. Afterward, he began his career as a Correction Officer. While working for the Maryland Division of Correction and Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services, Huber received many commendations: Certificate of Exemplary Service, Exemplary Job Performance, Exceptional Employees Achievement Award, Employee of the Month, and a Certificate of Promotion from sergeant to Correction Officer III. Affectionately known as Boo-Boo, Hubert was a loving and caring person who was very loyal to his friends and family, however, his heart belonged to his son, Jonathan. In his free time, he assisted in coaching every sport that Jonathan played which included baseball, soccer, and basketball.
