



Hubert Stewart

November 16, 1928 - January 26, 2017

Hubert Stewart, son of the late Daisy Stewart, entered this world on November 16, 1928 in Parkton, North Carolina. He departed this life on January 26, 2017 at the age of 88 after a lengthy illness.

Hubert received his education in the North Carolina school system. As a young man he joined the Army in 1951 and was honorably discharged in 1956 with a rank of Corporal. He worked many jobs, the longest of which (27 years) was with Social Security until his retirement in 1989.

In 1960, Hubert married the former Mary Williams, and from this union four children were born, Theresa (deceased), Tanya (deceased), Wanda Ann, and Herbert Vernard (deceased). Hubert had three siblings, two sisters and a brother whom all preceded him in death.

Hubert had dedicated his life to Christ and was a faithful member of the Historic St. Paul Community Baptist Church, where he served as a Deacon until his illness. Hubert loved to sing and serve the Lord. You could always find him singing one of his favorite songs, "God's Going to Straighten Out All His People when He Comes," on any given Sunday. In the 1980's, he was one of the founding members of the 'Solid Rock Vocal Choir' and even wrote a few songs. He was an avid gardener and was also known as a "jack-of-all trades". He was well loved by all and was always willing to help his fellow person.

He leaves to mourn: his devoted wife, Mary; his daughter, Wanda “Ann”; his granddaughters, Shaneka Harvey and Mrs. Deandra Afolabi (Taofeek); his great-grandchildren, Asia Price, Mecca Price, Anita Price, and Ty'Shawn Price; and a host of other cousins, nieces, nephews, family and friends.
