November 17, 1923 - June 22, 2005

On Wednesday, June 22, 2005, Ida Mae Addison Pryor departed this life after a lengthy illness. She was the daughter of the late Henry and Ida Viola Reese Addison of Bishopville, South Carolina. Ida Mae was educated in a "little school house" in South Carolina while still working in the fields with her mother. While in South Carolina, her family members call her "Tuttie". At the age of 19, Tuttie and her sister Mary Lou embarked on the trip north to Washington, D.C. Later she moved to Baltimore where she met and married the late James Walker. From this union one daughter (Leesa) was born. About 1950, William Pryor came into her life. They were married and from this union, two children, William Jr., deceased and Betty, were born and one child Juanita, deceased, was adopted as an infant. Always wanting to be connected to a Christian family, when she left her Christian family at Gunspring Baptist Church in South Carolina, in Baltimore, her first Christian family was on Caroline Street, pastured by the late Reverend Page, where she was a member for about 13 years. For the next 20 years, she held membership at the Mount Tabor Baptist Church on East Oliver Street where the Pastor was the late Reverend Mayo. As her steps got slower, the distance traveled got shorter. She became a member of Calvary Baptist Church on Garrison Boulevard for about five years. The pastor there was the late Reverend Graves. Slower still, her membership was changed to a church down the street, Park Lane Baptist Church on Granada Avenue. As the slowest of steps came upon her, she went to stay with her daughter Betty. While there, she

became a member of the same church as her daughter, Kedish House of Prayer Christian Church where the Pastor is James Mullen, where she held membership at the time of her death.
