IKE BROWN JR. suddenly departed this earthly life on Thursday June 18, 2020 at the age of 34. Ike was born on November 3, 1985 in Detroit, Michigan, where he lived his entire life. He is the son of Ike Brown Sr. and Eloise Brown, who have both preceded him in his journey to heaven. Ike was born at Henry Ford Hospital.

A quiet strength is how Ike could be described. Although Ike rarely expressed himself to others, he had a strong love for family and friends. His inner strength was shared through his love of writing poetry and songs.

Ike Jr. received his elementary education from Malcolm X Academy, where he further developed his gift for poetry and music. While studying at Malcolm X, Ike joined the choir to express himself. Singing was not limited only in school, but Ike was also a member of the choir at Second Grace Methodist Church in Detroit, Michigan. Ike's love of music helped to elevate his smooth quiet soul. Ike received his high school education from Detroit Community Academy. He continued to write songs and poetry while in high school. After graduation, Ike attended Wayne County Community College, where he studied Liberal Arts. After studying there, he transferred and received his Associates Degree from Henry Ford Community College in 2005. Ike, however, was not done with pursuing his education. He enrolled in Wayne State to study Criminal Justice.

Ike Jr. worked to fund his education as a Security Officer at the College of Creative Studies in Detroit, Michigan. He aspired to become a probation officer to help troubled youth. He had a quiet strength about him. Because Ike lost his parents as he was becoming a young man, Ike understood how to relate to those who felt as if they had no one to confide in. Ike was highly intelligent and humble. He only wished to share his wisdom and knowledge with others who may be able to talk to him openly, as he was a peer. Ike's strong spiritual connection helped him during some trying times in his life. Having a supportive sister and brother-in-law helped Ike get through some tough times. His desire to help others was a testament to his upbringing.

Ike is survived by his daughter, Payton Elizabeth Brown (age 10); sister, Ikesha Brown Phillips; brother-in-law, Julius Phillips; nephews, Aaron Johnson and Damon Grady. Ike also leaves behind a host of family including uncles, aunts, and cousin in Alabama, Maryland, and Michigan.
