Ikechukwu Chijindu Ogbonna was born in Aba General Hospital on April 20, 1987, to the Late Chief O. Joel Ogbonna and Mrs. Celia Ugonma Nzotta-Ogbonna. He departed from us on November 21, 2016 in Baltimore Maryland, at the age of 29 years.

Ike moved with his mother and sister to the United States in 1993, where he attended primary schooling in Maryland. He later attended Coppin State University Helene Fuld School of Nursing, where he obtained his Bachelors of Nursing Degree, with distinction and high honors. Fellow classmates and professors alike remember Ike as a positive role model and advocate, who “walked the walk and talked the talk.” He was employed as a nurse at The Johns Hopkins Hospital, in Baltimore, Maryland. There, he was known for his compassion, and care for his patients and coworkers.

Ike enjoyed traveling, charitable works and the company of friends. It was rare to see him without a huge smile that would light up a room. He will be remembered for his generosity and his trademark humor. He leaves behind memories of his selfless acts, motivation and all-round positive energy that he spread to whomever he encountered.
