Although she suffered personal challenges, she remained faithfully dedicated to her family, in particular her mother Beulah, with whom she referred as Mama, and later, her brother Rickey when he was no longer able to care for himself. She would prepare tasty meals, repair items in the family home, go to doctors appointments, go grocery shopping, and any other task that she could perform to lighten the load of her family. Despite not having children of her own, she loved her niece, nephews, aunts, uncles, and cousins. In 1987, she accepted the Lord as her personal savior.

A time to die. 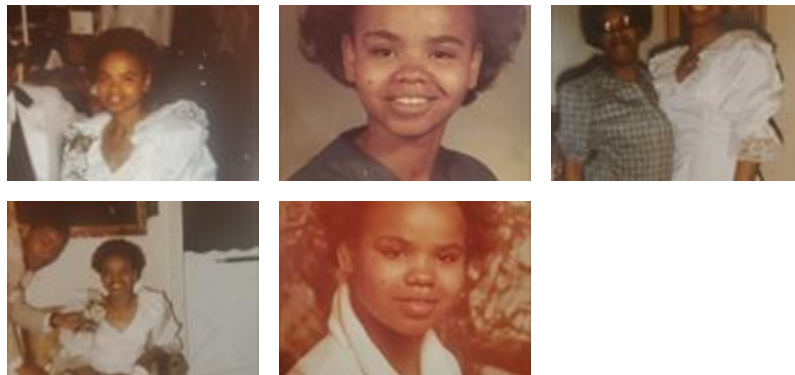
