December 26, 1940 - March 1, 2020

Ira Alfred Burrell, affectionately known to most as TY, departed this life on Sunday, March 1, 2020, after a lengthy illness. Born in New Kent County, Virginia, Ty was the son of the late Walter Edward Burrell, Sr., and Carrie Street Burrell.

Ty attended public schools in New Kent County and Accomack County, Virginia. After high school, Ty enlisted in the United States Navy in February, 1960. He had numerous active duty assignments aboard ship and on shore, stateside and abroad. After 23 years of distinguished service, Ty retired from active duty in February 1983. He continued to serve the Department of the Navy as a civil servant until his second retirement in May 1991.

Ty was preceded in death by two sisters, Josephine Brooks and Doris Gardner; three brothers Louis "San" Burrell, Howard Burrell, and Walter Burrell, Jr.; and one nephew raised with the family as a brother, Keith Hope.

In his retirement years, he enjoyed doing yard work, cutting wood, and building just about anything. However, his greatest joys were the times spent with Jane and his children and grandchildren, with fishing a close second.
