She departed this life on December 17, 2001 shortly after being diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. She received her education in the Baltimore City public schools earning a certificate of attendance and achievement (reading and math). Upon completion of her education, she received a certificate for Geriatric Nursing Assistant (GNA) assuming her duties at Westley Home, on 2211 Rogers Avenue in Baltimore (July 1943). On June 27, 1970, she married the late Edward S. Quince and later divorced. Out of this union, two children were born (Kathy and Carole). In December 1975, she became employed with the State of Maryland (highland Health Facility). She was dependable, diligent, trustworthy and often showed great interest in her patients who she was assigned to. After completing her work, she occasionally assisted her co-workers with the completion of their assignments. She later transferred to the Rosewood Center, and that is where she stayed until her retirement on January 1, 1995. Immediately after retirement, she became a full-time baby sitter for her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She leaves to mourn: three daughters, Diane Goines, Kathy Quince and Carole Quince-Swift; one step-son, Edward Quince, Jr.; one son-in-law, Omar Swift, Sr. a.k.a.
