



## Irma Green Mitchell

March 29, 1928 - June 23, 2025

On June 23, 2025 Irma Ozelia Green Mitchell transitioned to her heavenly home. She was predeceased by her parents, Arthur and Louise Green, 10 siblings, and her son, Frank Mitchell, Jr. Born on March 29, 1928, she was one of eleven children and the youngest of seven girls.

Irma was a graduate of Richmond Public Schools and attended Virginia Union University. She also attended St. Paul's Baptist Church at an early age and joined when she was a teenager. She married Frank Mitchell and together they had three children, Frank Mitchell Jr., Jacqueline Mitchell, and Marvin Mitchell.

A woman of many talents, Irma's beautiful voice afforded her the opportunity to share her gift as she sung in the church choir. She acquired a love of music and singing from her older brother, Arthur, who taught her many of the songs that he sang in the Armstrong High School Choir. Not only did Irma enjoy music and singing, she was exceptional in sewing. Many Saturdays she would cut out a dress, sew it and wear it to church the next day. Some Saturdays, she even made two dresses, one for herself and one for her daughter, Jackie.

Irma was employed as a seamstress for over 20 years at The Jefferson Manufacturing Company until they moved their operations overseas. She was later employed by Western Electric Company as a printer of circuit boards.

Left to cherish her memory, Irma is survived by her daughter, Jacqueline D. Mitchell; her son, Marvin Mitchell; three grandchildren, Tara Bagby, Tonya Witcher, and Nicole Mitchell; five great grandchildren; thirteen great great grandchildren; and a host of nieces, nephews and friends.
