Irvo "Young Vo" Noel Otieno was suddenly and inhumanely stolen away from his family and friends, at the age of 28, on March 6, 2023, as a result of the actions of people who failed to uphold their oaths of public safety.

He was born on December 17, 1994, the son of Caroline A. Ouko (née Yugi) and the late Moses Ouko Membo. Irvo was a gregarious baby, a lively toddler, an energetic child, a fun-loving, athletic teen, and an artistic young man. A man that loved life, his family, friends and his puppy, Papi. He loved the outdoors -- walking in the serene woods, trips to the beach, and more. Irvo was kind, he loved, respected, and valued people and his community.

He attended Henrico County Public Schools and graduated from Douglas Freeman High School, Class of 2012. Irvo was a star athlete who played basketball and football earning an athletic scholarship to attend college.

Irvo penned poignant, meaningful, and expressive lyrics as he worked on

building a music career and his own record label, Young Vo Records. He used his songs to detail his experiences, ambitions and to shine a light on social issues, while celebrating his momma and loved ones.

Irvo leaves to cherish his memory his loving mother, siblings Leon, Syprose, Clifford, Marion; aunts Millicent Yugi Ohonde and Elizabeth Obado-Dolla (née Yugi); other aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.
