September 1, 1928 - October 15, 2024

Isabella Hudson was born to Louis and Effie Hudson on August 22, 1928, in Lynchburg, South Carolina. She moved to Maryland with her family during her childhood.

Isabella attended Harvey Johnson Junior High and Carver Vocational High School, later earning credits from Baltimore City Community College.

On December 14, 1947, Isabella married James O. Randall, and together they raised three children: Dr. Louis N. Randall, MD, Cynthia Taylor, and Bernadette McCraw.

A cherished bond developed over the years with her grandson, James, who regularly visited and assisted her with various tasks.

Isabella dedicated 23 years of her life as a nursing assistant at the University of Maryland Medical System, retiring at the age of 57 in 1985. In her retirement, she generously volunteered at her church kitchen and cared for sick relatives. She treasured vacations with her children and grandchildren and was an active member of New Psalmist Baptist Church. Isabella passed away on October 15, 2024, at the age of 96.

One lesser-known aspect of Isabella's life was her profound love for dogs. Her
