Douglas graduated from Baltimore City College High School and received his Bachelor's Degree from Morgan State University on May 31, 1970. Purdie in 1977 and was a devoted husband and her very Best Friend. "Doug" was employed as a Juvenile Court Coordinator for the State of Maryland under the Developmental Disabilities Administration. He was very personable and made numerous friends wherever he went. He was a family man who enjoyed the pleasures of home. He was skilled in carpentry and redesigning and used those skills to single-handedly renovate his home to make it more comfortable for his family.
