Isiah Trimava Hodge, Sr. (aka “Red” and “MR. Hodge”), was born on February 12, 1928 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina to the late Ethel Harvey and Benjamin Hodge. “Red”, as he was affectionately called by family and close friends in Winston, developed a strong work ethic starting at age 12 at the local grocery store. Having this work ethic served him well when he was lured “up North” to the big city. It was there that he obtained a position as a Psychiatric Technician at Kings County Hospital in Brooklyn, New York for the next 32 years.
