A self-made business owner I've been making money since Elementary school because I was creative and crafty I took the free lunches added lettuce and tomatoes and then sold them to the maintenance men, I throw card parties, stripper parties, I babysat, I was a Avon Rep, I had bake sale, a candy store, frozen cups, snowballs, I crotched blankets and sold, I planned and decorated all types of parties, but my biggest money maker was the clothes, dinners I sold, and my famous Easter Baskets thanks to Clem and Gina I had Social Security on lock down I knew their paydays better than my two sisters.
