Mr. James Wallace Grant, Sr., son of Mrs. Rebecca Grant and the late Urie Grant was born on June 23, 1944 in Chester County, South Carolina. He departed this life on March 2, 2012.

Mr. Grant enlisted in the United States Army in 1965 and served for three years. He obtained the rank of Sergeant and served as a paratrooper and a member of the elite Green Beret Special Forces. For his service he received a National Defense Service Medal. He later attended Morgan State University and received a B.A. Degree in Urban Studies in 1978.

Mr. Grant worked as a Supervisor at IMF Post Office for thirty four years and retired early to pursue other interests. Mr. Grant was affiliated with A-Plus, the Buffalo Soldiers and supported and donated to numerous charities to include the Helping Up Mission.
