James Wallace Moore, the eldest child of Clarence and Denise Moore was born in Baltimore, Maryland, on April 12, 1971. James was preceded in death by his brother, Darryl Moore. He departed this life suddenly on September 8, 2019.

James received his education through the Baltimore City Public School System. His early education began at Northwood Elementary School, where he developed a lifelong relationship with his 5th grade teacher, Annie B. Davis-Baughn. Later, James attended Lake Clifton High School where he was an active member of the Jr. ROTC.

After graduating in 1989, James joined the Baltimore City Police Department; as a cadet he worked in the Central District. Upon graduating from the Police Academy, he was assigned to the Western District, working as both an Officer and Detective. James left the Police Department and began a career in the Automotive Industry. He began his career as a salesperson but that career evolved into one of an automotive financier and a licensed insurance broker. James was a natural in this role and was regarded by all as the 'top of his game' as an automotive financier. He also earned many accolades during his career, including 'Best Boss' and induction into the Finance and Insurance Elite Society.

At an early age, James attended Mt. Pleasant Church, where he remained an active member for 17 years. His Christian education continued at Friendship Baptist Church under the leadership of Dr. William J. McCoy, Pastor, where he was an active participant in the youth department. James later joined Huber Memorial Church, where he was an active member of the Men's Ministry and served, at one point, as the President of the Youth and Young Adult Choir.

Huber was also where James met the love of his life, Robin T. Hamlin. This loving couple was wed on August 18, 2001, and celebrated 18 years of wedded bliss, shortly before his untimely passing. James was a devoted husband and dutiful provider, ensuring that wife's needs were met throughout their union

James was a wonderful and devoted father to Devin Brenton Moore (1993), who preceded him in death and Aliya Muhammad (1995). In 2014, James welcomed becoming a grandfather and was overjoyed with the birth of his grandson, Noah. James often said that he, "lived for these two "pickle-heads".

James loved life and family. He was always certain to make sure that his family was well taken care of. As a young man he enjoyed playing baseball with the Northwood baseball league. As an adult he 'gave back', by coaching softball. James also loved bowling, fishing, visiting the gun range, riding his spider (bike) and exploring new places. James also loved singing, and was known by all who knew him well, for his sense of humor-he loved to laugh and make others laugh too; his laughter was unforgettable. James was also the self-proclaimed #1 fan of Steve Harvey's Family Feud and often expressed his desire to compete on the show. As far as the Ravens are concerned, his last day on this earth was spent cheering them on to victory, during their season opener.

James and his Mother shared a special, unique relationship. To his Mom, James was not only a son, he was also a Father, Counselor, Boss and Confidante. He will be greatly missed.
