JAMES EDWARD TUCKER, son of the late Theodore R. and Susie Tucker, was born on December 14, 1939 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on May 27, 2020, after a lengthy illness.

He graduated from Paul Lawrence Dunbar High School in Baltimore. He served three years in the U.S. Army before pursuing a career in the federal government. He held various positions as a federal employee, including supervisor with the Social Security Administration; analyst with the Food and Drug Administration. After retiring from federal service, he owned and operated commercial and residential janitorial cleaning service for 25 years. He attended the Virginia Seminary and College where he received a bachelor's degree in Theology in 1975, Master's of Divinity in 1978, and Doctor of Ministry in 1979. He served as an associate minister at Sharon Baptist Church, Cornerstone Church of Christ, and Leadenhall Baptist Church, and pastored New Jerusalem Church of Christ from 1983-1988.

He married the former Dianna L. Coleman, and out of this union two children were born. He also had six other children from previous marriages.

James loved the Lord and would advise anyone in need of spiritual encouragement and understanding. He taught theology for several years at the Maryland Baptist Center and School of Religion in Baltimore. He was a

friend to many and extremely devoted to his immediate and extended family.

James was preceded in death by parents, Theodore and Susie; brothers, Stanley, Alexander, and Jerry; sisters, Eleanora and Shirley; and son, Theodore (Teddy).
