Her response to them was usually “hello pumpkin” with so much affection. Her greeting to adults was with the same affection and enthusiasm as with children. She would often say, “Hey stranger, where you been?” Janet never met a stranger she didn’t like and was always neighborly. Janet greeted everyone with an infectious smile and would hardly ever complain or had something bad to say just like her mother, Doris Lee. She was very outgoing and always looking for any opportunity to have a good time whether attending a Bull Roast, Crab Feast, Cabaret, or family

gathering. One of her favorite pastimes was listening to her Oldies but Goodies music selections.

Janet was a beautiful baby at birth with her blue eyes and blonde hair. She was truly a miracle child who succumbed to lead poisoning. This resulted in slight brain damage and the temporary loss of her hearing and sight. However, with a lot of prayer and through the grace of God her hearing and sight was restored.

In January of 2009, Janet was relocated to Bradford Oaks Center in Clinton, Maryland where she resided until her passing. Janet fought a great battle with cancer, but on February 13, 2013 Ash Wednesday, her Guardian Angels came by to help her make her final journey. Janet will be truly missed by her family, friends and neighbors.
