Jasper graduated from Armstrong High School and later attended Virginia Union University. It was there he met the love of his life, Julia of 40 years.

At the age of 26, Jasper became a director for the East End YMCA. He was a passionate and committed servant to youth in the community and his church New Covenant Apostolic. Jasper retired from Richmond Public Schools as a Safety Resource Specialist, Eddie Eagle Gun Control Coordinator and numerous other positions.

He was also an avid and devoted Bible Teacher who enjoyed sharing the Wealth of God's word with God's people. Jasper was a kind and humorous, but stern gentleman who often quoted the likes of C.S. Lewis and R.C. Sproul.

Jasper excepted Christ at the age of 9 years old. He was first ordained a Missionary and from there he excelled to minister, youth minister, choir
