Jean H. Kelly, daughter of the late Mary and Howard Kelley, was born January 1st, 1944, in Baltimore, Maryland. Out of this union, she was the eldest child with a younger brother named George.

She departed this life suddenly on April 29th at the University of Maryland Medical Center.

Jean accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Faith Baptist Church. She was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and graduated from Eastern High School and Cortez W. Peters Business College.

She made a full career working at the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration and retired after 25 years of service.

In the midst of her declining health, she found joy when she moved in with her son Eric, who took exceptionally good care of her.

She did not want for anything - he attended to her every need. She was at peace.

She was loved and will be greatly missed.

Jean was preceded in death by her parents, Mary and Howard Kelley.
