OUR BELOVED JEAN CONSTANCE SUTTON-TAYLOR, 81, WAS BORN ON MAY 9, 1938, DEPARTED THIS LIFE NOVEMBER 7, 2019.

JEAN WAS A GRADUATE OF MAGGIE L. WALKER IN 1954 AT THE AGE OF 16. SHE VISITED THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY DURING THE CIVIL RIGHTS ERA IN 1964. IT WAS A BAD TIME IN OUR COUNTRY'S HISTORY AND SHE AND OTHERS WERE NOT WELCOMED THERE. SHE BECAME A LPN AND WORKED AT THE VA HOSPITAL THROUGHOUT THE 70'S AND EARLY 80'S. SHE THEN WENT ON TO WORK THE REST OF HER NURSING CAREER AT VARIOUS ADULT CARE FACILITIES BEFORE RETIRING IN 1999 TO CARE FOR HER HUSBAND UNTIL HIS PASSING.

JEAN WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER MOTHER BERTHA C. KING, FATHER ARCHIE JOHNSON, HER HUSBAND WYLIE TAYLOR, AND HER SISTERS JOYCE K. THORPE AND JANET COATES.
