Jean Renee Wright, affectionately known as Jeanie, Aunt Jeanie, Grannie and JeanBean to her family and close friends, was born Jean Renee Henson on August 12, 1953 to Yvonne D. Henson and Wesley B. Henson Sr. in Baltimore, MD.

Jeanie graduated from Edmondson High School (1971) and while there she met the love of her life Gregory D. Wright (a.k.a. Hazim Talib Abdulghaffar); they soon began dating, and not long afterwards got engaged, and gave birth to their first daughter Stacie Renee Wright. While attending Coppin State (now Coppin State University), Jean and Gregory D. Wright were married in 1974 and several years later gave birth to a second daughter Ebonie Dionne Wright. It would be sixteen years before they would give birth to their third daughter Shakirah Fatima Abdulghaffar. Gregory D. Wright (a.k.a. Hazim Talib Abdulghaffar) preceded Jeanie in death on July 13, 2000.

At a very young age, Jeanie developed a passion for education. She displayed that passion as a substitute teacher at her alma mater Edmondson High School for several years.
