



## Jeffrey V. Leggs

July 6, 1962 - April 1, 2018

Jeffrey Vincent Leggs, son of the late Duval Edward Leggs and Shirley Ann Leggs was born on July 6, 1962 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on April 1, 2018 on Easter Sunday.

He was the second born son of three. He was Baptized in the New Elizabeth Baptist Church on May 20, 1973 at the age of 10 along with his brothers. Jeff received his education in Baltimore City Public Schools. He attended Greenspring Junior High School from 1975 to 1977 where he joined the school band as a drummer and learned to read music. As a highlight, Jeff performed in a talent show with his neighborhood band "Dark Atmosphere" and won 1st place. In 1977 he attended Baltimore Poly Technical Institute for one year and joined the chess club where he defeated the reigning chess champion and noted the club was then closed the next day. He would often carry around a mini magnetic chess board and would beat all his neighborhood friends, to include his brothers. In 1978 he transferred to Mergenthaler Vocational-Technical High School (Mervo) where he excelled in the electronics program and was the top student of his graduating class. His success led to his recruitment by Baltimore Gas & Electric (BGE) where he started in the apprenticeship program.

Jeff was the only African American technician in the program which then opened doors for other recruitments of Mervo students to follow. He worked for BGE for 21 years as an electronic technician until April 26, 2002. During his time at BGE he would repair electronic equipment and appliances which

included tv's, radios, stereos, VCRs and closed-circuit security cameras at the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant. For the next 5 years he would buy and repair homes for sale.

Jeff had many hobbies which included cooking, grilling, karate, space adventure movies and playing video games. His favorite hobbies were playing drums, keyboards, listening to and making his own musical recordings. He would also collect exotic model cars and toy cars for his grandson.

He would later become a care-giver for his mother on a daily basis when she fell ill to health complications. In later years, Jeff began to experience the same medical complications as his mother. He fought a courageous medical battle for over 10 years of his life up until his homegoing. Although ill, he reflected a mental toughness and still had the ability to go about life and to laugh and joke with family and friends. Lastly, Jeff was a very giving person who would often assist other in need.

Jeff is survived by: Daughter, Keyonna M. Leggs, Grandson Keelyn J. Barnes; two Brothers, Michael A. Leggs and Kyle B. Leggs (Lt. Col., Ret.); two sister-in-law, Olivia and Kim Leggs; Uncle Nathaniel E. Jones, Jr., Esquire; Aunt Helen Gilchrist; Niece, Britney S. Leggs; three Nephews, Brian E. Leggs, Byron M. Leggs, and Dominique E. Leggs; and a host of cousins and friends.
