Jesse Edward Brown, Jr. was born on July 8, 1964 to the Late Jesse Edward Brown, Sr. and Dorothy Brown-Tiller. He was suddenly called home to be with the Lord on January 6, 2017.

Jesse accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior at the age of 9 years old. He was baptized at Rising Mt. Zion Baptist Church. He was educated in Henrico County Public School System and after graduation entered into the service of the United States Navy at the at the age of 17.

During his time in active service as a Cryptologic Technician (CTR2) and after tours of duty in

California, Japan, Guam, and various east coast locations, he served on the USS Valley Forge.

He received numerous awards for his outstanding performance in the U .S. Navy. During his off-duty hours, CTR2 J..E. Brown spearheaded the Navy's ADOPT-A-SCHOOL Program while on the USS Valley Forge and was recognized with letters of commendation.
