



## Jesse James Hooks

June 11, 1930 - January 7, 2015

JESSE JAMES HOOKS, son of the late Jesse Hooks and Straudie B. Ewing, was born on June 11, 1930 in Lee County, Georgia. He departed this life on January 7, 2015 at Northwest Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland, after a lengthy illness.

Jesse moved to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in his early years and completed his primary education in the Pittsburgh Public School system. At the age of eighteen he enrolled into the United States Army, where he served during the Korean War, earning many declarations including one bronze and two silver stars.

After the completion of his military service, he worked a multitude of positions over the years, both in the Baltimore and Pittsburgh areas.

He married the late Barbara Hooks (Lamar), and out of this union one child was born, Lisa Reid.

Jesse worked for Gulf Oil and Chevron Corporations before leaving the Pittsburgh area to work at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, from which he retired in July, 2000.

He leaves to mourn two daughters, Lisa Reid (Hooks) and Janell Hooks; one son, Nathaniel Rolle; one sister, Barbara Solomon; three grand-children, David Rayzer, Miles Reid and Braeylin Maybin; three sisters-in-law, Loretta Hooks, Audrey Ralph and Shirley Robertson; a host of nieces, nephews; a very special devoted companion, Ruth Hurtt; and many other friends and relatives.
