JESSE WEBSTER SNOWDEN was born December 30, 1920 and departed this life on November 4, 2013 at the age of ninety-two. He was born in Darlington, Maryland to Samuel and Mary Snowden and was the eighth of ten children.

Jesse received his formal education in Harford County public schools before entering the United States Army. He completed a tour of duty in World War II before being honorably discharged on November 29, 1948.

In May, 1953 Jesse married Clara Shelton who preceded him in death. From this union four children were born, Barbara, Carolyn, Linda and Jesse, Jr. He was also a loving stepfather to Harold Shelton who also preceded him in death.

Jesse continued providing service to the Army as a civilian working over thirty years between the posts at Edgewood Arsenal and Aberdeen Proving Ground. During this time he held many positions and received several citations while performing as an Army Motor Vehicle Driver and an Engineering Equipment Operator before retiring in 1979.

Jesse thoroughly enjoyed his retirement years and became a faithful member of Union Baptist Church where he continued to worship whenever his health permitted. Jesse enjoyed cooking and the family looked forward to his holiday meals especially his moist turkeys, macaroni and cheese and string beans. Even when he could no longer lift the turkey he still prepared the turkey dressing and vegetables.

Jesse leaves to cherish his memory: his sister, Juliet; daughters, Barbara, Carolyn and Linda; son, Jesse, Jr.; son-in-law, Larry; daughter-in-law, Leila; seven grandchildren, a host of great- grandchildren, nieces, nephews and friends.

Jesse was a person of few words, but always wore a smile. He will be sorely missed.
