Mrs. Jessie Bell Dinkins Wiggins, age 97, died of natural causes on Sunday Evening, May 17, 2020 at home in Pikesville, Maryland while in the loving care of her daughter Erma. Jessie Wiggins was born on December 22, 1922 in Sumter County, South Carolina to Robert Dinkins, Sr. and Inez McDuffie Dinkins both deceased.
