January 6, 1932 - March 17, 2002

Center” nursing facility. Jessie Mae had a healthy appetite and loved to eat! She was a gentle soul, but had no problem in telling you what was on her mind. Jessie Mae loved the Lord! You could often times hear her clapping her hands and singing praises to his name. She loved to sing her “church songs.” Jessie Mae leaves to cherish her memory: stepmother, Rena Lee Robinson; two sisters, Elnita Bethea and Ella Queen Stevenson; one brother, Elisha Reaves; one brother-in-law, Milton A.
