



## Joe Louis Hunt

February 9, 1936 - January 5, 2025

MR. JOE LOUIS HUNT was born in Grimesland, North Carolina, a small town outside of Greenville, North Carolina. He was the first born child to the marriage union of the late Mr. Etherbert Hunt and the late Mrs. Ella Green-Hunt. Four others were born, all of whom have preceded Mr. Hunt in death (Geraldine, Cecil, Yvonne and Douglas).

The late Mr. Etherbert Hunt migrated to Baltimore, MD and stayed with relatives until he secured an apartment in the old St. Mary's Seminary building for young perspective priests located on Pennsylvania Avenue between St. Mary's Street and Franklin Street. That building is now a home for senior citizens. Joe was tall and strong. He worked with his dad in the produce industry until he became gainfully employed at the Davison Chemical Company where he worked his way up through the rank and file. He suffered an injury from a chemical spill but remained there until he retired.

In 1955, he met and married the late Miss Janet Lee Taylor-Hunt, and from that union six children were born, Barbara Ann, Gary and Joseph, Jr. (three have preceded him in death).

Mr. Hunt accepted Christ at the Good Shepherd Baptist Church but strayed away. He recently was reinstated by his long lost sister Min. Sheila

Mason of the Manifested Glory Worship Center under the leadership of Bishop Damon Johnson, Sr.

Mr. Joe Louis Hunt is survived by: two sons, Curtis (Denise) and Timothy; one daughter, Angela Ausby, fourteen grandchildren, twenty-five great grandchildren, cousins, nieces, nephews, friends, and neighbors. Joe was a people-person.
