Joe Lewis Hubbard was born on April 6, 1938, in Carlton, Georgia to the late Clenton Powers and Lucille Hubbard. He departed his earthly life on January 9, 2003 after a brief illness. After receiving his public education from the Detroit Public School System, Joe joined the United States Navy on October 10, 1955, being honorably discharged on September 15, 1959. A very unique person, Joe always had a smile on his face and something inspirational to say to any and all people with whom he came in contact. He loved to be called, Jose Gonzalez and enjoyed singing praises to God for the miraculous wonders He preformed in his life. One of those wonders was meeting Betty Lou Whelchel at a dance at the YMCA in November 1953 and falling instantly in love with her. They were married on December 31, 1956. Joe stressed the importance of education with his sons and lost no opportunity to announce that all three completed college. His zest for life and his need to provide strong stability for his family made him seek various types of employment throughout the state of Maryland from Pariser's Bakery, Bethlehem Steel Corporation, the United States Coast Guard, to the Baltimore County Public School System. Always industrious, Joe's greatest love was baking and he would frequently seek part-time employment at various bakeries around the city and county. During his life, he was an active member of Gillis Memorial Christian Community Church where he proudly

served as the Sergeant-at-Arms in the Male Chorus. He also served as the Chairperson of the Men's Day Committee. Joe's great love, faith and strength will live on in his family: his devoted wife, Betty; children, Adrian, Joel, and Anthony; daughters-in-law, Deborah and Stephanie; grandchildren, Christopher, Brian, William, and Cameron; and a host of nieces, nephews, and other relatives.
