John Campbell, Jr. was born 16,1923 in Richmond,Va. He was the youngest of three born to John and Azilee Campbell,Sr. He was educated in the Richmond Public School system and was a graduate of Maggie Walker High School, where he acquired the name "Breezy" because of his smooth performance on the basketball court. He carried his team to win the 1942 State Championship. He furthered his education at Virginia State University until he was called upon by his country to serve in the United States Army during World War II. After his tour, John returned home where he decided to attend barber school and upon graduating, he and a close friend opened a barber shop. In addition to serving his country, he later chose to accept employment with the Veterans Administration for more than 30 years.

In 1948 John met and married the love of his life Bertha June Campbell,of this union came 5 children; John III, Charmaine, Everett, Byron, and Anthony. John was a family man and spent every Sunday dedicated to family time with his children. He accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age. He was a faithful member of Sixth Mount Zion Baptist Church(Richmond, VA) for more than 50 years where he served on the Usher Ministry. John was a passionate sports fan and he loved the Washington Redskins;"he was not to be disturbed when the game was on".
