He first worked at John Hopkins University as a researcher in the department of Biology. There, he conducted groundbreaking research and received international recognition. He later on left John Hopkins to seek to conduct research on his own, with the purpose of finding a cure for cancer. John Noel has published extensively in top raking journals in the fields of pharmacology and toxicology.

John loved God and made Him the center of his life. He also loved others, and was a very hospitable man. He made numerous friends wherever he went, and will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him.
