February 23, 1927 - July 27, 2020

On February 23, 1927 in Calvert County, Maryland, Walter and Florence Graham welcomed John and his twin brother Nathaniel. John attended public schools in Calvert County, Maryland and worked as an oysterman, until he joined the military in 1945.

He didn't just join the military to protect our country in time of war, but he made it his career and served for twenty-five years. John was a Staff Sergeant and a Chief of the USAF Fire Protection Unit where he served through wartime and peace, often speaking of his journeys throughout the world. During his time in the military he met and married the love of his life, Rozella, in a quiet ceremony on Easter, April 21, 1957. The young couple didn't have much time to spend together as John left to go overseas the very next day while Rozelia remained at home and pursued her passion, educating young minds.

When John returned, the happy couple, moved to Massachusetts and began a family. They welcomed Jonathan in 1965 and while stationed in California, Toi was born in 1967. John would retire from the military in 1970 and relocated to Baltimore where he worked in several supervisory positions until he retired again in 1991.

After 58 years of marriage, Rozelia was called home on April 30, 2015. After her passing, he went to live in York and was cared for by his granddaughter Jasmine, his son, Jonathan, wife Teresa, Cheyenne and Jonathan II.

John was preceded in death by his wife, Rozelia, his parents Walter and

Florence, seven brothers, Harry, Nathaniel, Norman, Fred, Herman, Walter and James and seven sisters, Mary Alice, Florence, Mamie, Antoinette, Pearl, Odessa and Mattie.

John leaves to cherish his memory: his brother, Briscoe Graham, son Gilbert Graham (wife Angela), son Jonathan Graham (wife Teresa), and his daughter, Toi Dorm (husband Daren), six grandchildren: Jasmine, Bethany, Cheyenne, Jonathan II, Quincy, Mya and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
