John Miles, Sr. was born April 3, 1911 to the late Richard and Harriett Myles of Lugoff, S.C. Years later John relocated to Richmond, Virginia where he later met and married Lucille B. Carlos, and was united for sixty-eight years. To the union of John and Lucille were born eight children, six sons: John Jr., Jesse, James, Curtis, and Larry; and two daughters, Juanita and Chriscenia (Marqueta). 'Pop' Miles, as he was called by many, believed in taking care of his family. He worked two and three jobs at a time to provide for them. Throughout his lifetime, he was employed at Lucky Strike Tobacco Company, Bonds Bakery, Williams Bakery, Federal Bakery, and Huguenot Apartment Complex. He was preceded in death by one daughter Daisy Jones, two sons Jerry Miles and Elder Jesse Miles. One son, James Miles, is listed as missing in action in Viet Nam. Pop leaves to cherish his memories his loving and devoted wife, District Missionary Lucille B. Miles; two devoted daughters, Juanita Sherman (Aaron), and Chriscenia Porter; three sons, John Jr. (Katie), Curtis (Brenda), Pastor Larry C. (Terraine); one brother, Cain (Denise); one daughter-in-law, Justine; one devoted sister-in-law, Margaret DuBose (Sanford); twenty-seven grandchildren, one affectionately called Boo Boo; 17 great-grandchildren; two great great-grands, one devoted niece, Marie Myles of Philadelphia, PA; and a host of other nieces, nephews, relatives and friends. Pop Miles was a man of great wisdom and very prudent to only have achieved a third grade education. He was formerly a member of the St. Mark C.O.G.I.C, under the leadership of the late Supt.
