Born in Richmond, Virginia on February 13, 1923, John Wesley Smith was the first-born son of the late Isaiah and Eva (Canady) Smith who brought forth Ruby V. Smith, Alease Alston (deceased), Edward Smith (deceased), Eva Bowers (deceased) and Paul B. Smith.

John Wesley Smith grew up during the era of the Roaring Twenties, the Great Depression, the ratification of the 19th, 20th, and 21st amendments to the Constitution and the beginning of World War II. He proudly served in the army of the United States of America as a soldier who served in the Normandy, Northern France campaigns.
