JOHN CARL WOMACK, son of the late Frank Cole and Ms. Flora Womack, he was born on August 6, 1939 in Gretna, Virginia. He departed this life after a lengthy illness.

He received Christ at an early age and was a member of Elba Baptist Church in Gretna, Virginia.

He received his education at Northside High School. After graduating, he went straight into the United States Air Force where he served six years as a Staff Sergeant. He later left the Air Force to fight in the Vietnam War, then he worked at Kennecott Copper Refinery Company for fifteen to twenty years. From there he went on disability. He then married Anne Marie Womack on April 17, 1965 and out of that union was one child, Mrs. Jaclyn Marie Womack-Wynn. He was proud of his grandchildren. His passions that he loved were dancing, racetrack and bowling.

He was the first Black man to bowl a 700 score at Bowl America, Glen Burnie. His nickname in bowling was "Killer." He received a plaque and a ring for the 700 bowling score. He made friends wherever he went. He will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him. He was always a true friend and would help anyone he could at anytime. He was a kind hearted father and grandfather. He helped his daughter and grandchildren when he was needed.
