She loved music and singing. While she was a member of new Pilgrim Baptist Church, she sang in the choir. She has been a member of the Greater Gethsemane Missionary Baptist Church for many years. In 1987, she and Elloss had a grand celebration of their fiftieth wedding anniversary with many family members and friends in attendance. Before her retirement, Johnnie Mae worked for several Baltimore companies including Continental Can, Johns Hopkins Hospital and Domino Sugar. She also worked as a domestic helper for many years.
