May 13, 1933 - March 14, 2017

Joseph (Joe) Cassidy, 83, passed away peacefully at the Sunrise Assisted Living Facility in Pikesville, Maryland on March 14, 2017. He was born May 13, 1933 in White Plains, New York.

He was the only child of Joseph W. and Gertrude P. Cassidy. He graduated from White Plains High School, class of 1951. From there, he went to Morgan State College, and received a Bachelor of Science in Health and Physical Education in 1955. He then attended New York University, and received an MA in Secondary Physical Education in 1957. He then worked in the town of Greenberg, New York as Teacher-Coordinator of Elementary Physical Education until June 1960.

During his 33 year professional career, he held teaching jobs in the Baltimore City Public School System. These included Garrison Junior High School, in Baltimore, MD 1960; Clifton Park Junior High School 1962, Dunbar High School 1962-1965, Fairmount Hills Jr./Sr. High School 1967, Frederick Douglass High School from 1967-1980, Edmondson Westside High School from 1980 until his retirement in 1993 as Department Head/Athletic Director. In 1989 he received the Maryland State Athletic Association District Athletic Director of the Year, District 8 while at Edmondson Westside High School.

He is preceded in death by his wife of 43 years, Barbara Christler Cassidy and

his great-grandchild, Nedeljko Williams Jr.
