Joseph Dean McMillion was born in Baltimore, Maryland on July 14, 1960 to Wade and Maggie McMillion. God called our love one home on Friday, November 13, 2020.

Joseph was the youngest of 8 children and affectionately called “Joe Joe” by friends and family. He was raised closely with his Uncle Bud’s children and could be seen ripping and running the neighborhood with his cousins. He shared a special bond with his cousin, David McMillion, as they took frequent trips down south together with their fathers.

He received his education from the Baltimore City Public School System and earned a Certificate of Completion from Lincoln Tech.

In 1980 his first child, Lakeisha A. McMillion, was born but preceded him in death. In 1981 he had a second child, Latoya K. McMillion, and in 1984 a third daughter, Lakeria P. McMillion. In May of 1985 he had his first son, Jasmen J. McMillion.
