He spent his early childhood as an only child because he was much younger than his mother's two older children, Lillie Bell and Connie Lee Franklin, who were already married. After the death of his father, while still a young boy, his mother sent him to live with his older adopted sister and her husband, Walter Thomas Alford, Sr. Upon moving in their home he eventually came to regard them as his surrogate parent, even as he continued to have a loving relationship with his adopted mother until her death. In his sister's home, Joe was reared as the older sibling to her children and he was always regarded and respected as their "big brother" ...for the rest of his life. He was a loving and protective big brother.

Growing up in a family where he was now the oldest meant that he quickly learned that he had to set an example for the younger children. He was an obedient child, requiring little discipline. Joe attend Asbury Elementary School in Lamar, South Caroline.
