JOSEPH SNELLING, the seventh child of the late Julius H. and Virginia Snelling was born on March 12, 1965 in the Bronx, New York. After a brief illness, he was called home to glory on Wednesday, November 14, 2012 in Baltimore, Maryland. Joseph was preceded in death by his brothers, Reginald, Marcus and Kenneth.

Joseph was educated in the Bronx Public School System. He attended Samuel Gompers High School in the Bronx, New York. Joseph was the baby of the family and he loved the attention that status brought him throughout his life. Joseph and his brothers shared a passion for music. They all played in a drum and bugle corp growing up in New York. Joseph had a love for animals. As a young man, he worked in a veterinary clinic in the Bronx. In August 1987, Joseph married the former Mira Ramos.

Five years ago, Joseph met and fell in love with Linda Hicks. She was a devoted and caring girlfriend to Joseph until his death. Joseph shared his life with Linda, her daughter, Malinda and his “step grandchildren”, Kyriel, Tavone, Jalyn, Donavin, Keon and Isiah.
