He was the first African American to perform in the theater in Syracuse University. Jo-Jo loved football. He attended Ottawa University on a football scholarship and then transferred to Cowan college approximately a year later. Jo-Jo was loved by all who he came into contact with.

He had the wonderful gift of making all people feel loved and appreciated. There was never a time where he would not go out of his way to help others. A smile was always brought to all faces you when you asked Jo-Jo how he was, his response never failed to "Better when I see good people like you". He will be in our hearts always and forever, he will be missed.
