Joshua Clinton Cousin was born August 2, 1932, to the late Sarah Jane Sparrows and Fred L. Cousin Sr. in, Nelson County, Gladstone, Virginia. As a youth, he moved from Appomattox County, Virginia to Turners Station in Dundalk, MD. where he attended Turners Elementary. In 1951, during the time of the draft where men were being sent to fight in the Korean War, Joshua felt a duty to serve his country. Not meeting the minimum age requirement at the time and his mother not wanting to sign for him, Joshua had to “put his age up” so that he could enlist in the Army.

Once in the Army, Joshua said the physical training was very hard, but his life of living in the country prepared him for it. During his time in the Army, he was stationed at Camp Roberts in California. It was at this assignment where he became a Paratrooper. He was a part of the black servicemen group to become a real” FLY” guy. He had 27 jumps while serving in Army.

Although Joshua wasn’t that good of a cook, he did manage to make something the Officers really enjoyed and as a result they promoted him to the rank of Corporal. Joshua served in the military until 1953.

In 1955 he began working for General Motors. He worked his way up to become a Forman and retired in 1994 after 39 years with the organization.

Joshua was a confirmed bachelor for many years until he met and married the lovely Elaine Olivia Clark. They were married for 49 years and out of that marriage, they had one son, Brian.

Joshua was stern, but always ready with a smile and full of laughter. He was fond of saying "I was just Joshing". Joshua was a renaissance man he knew little bit about everything. He was known for his love of Corvettes and cars in general. He loved tinkering with cars around his home. Joshua was a skilled handyman who enjoyed fixing things in his home. But also enjoyed fixing things for friends and family as well. He was trustworthy, straightforward and a man of integrity. If he couldn't help you, he would figure out a way if it could be done but he wouldn't hurt you either. He loved and was very supportive of his family.

Joshua departed this life on Sunday, March 22, 2020, after a lengthy illness. He was preceded in death by his loving wife, Elaine and his son Donald. His sisters, Helen, Virginia and Ruth Inez. His brothers Fred, Jim, John, Ivanhoe, and Walter. Also, his mother Sarah and father Fred.

Joshua leaves to mourn, two children, Brian and Leslie; Grandchildren, Alexander, Royal Christopher, Colby and Marnae; and several nieces, great-nieces, nephews, great-nephews; and many more relatives in his hometown as well as friends and acquaintances in Baltimore.
